Vega Sindoa, Chardonnay, Cabernet, and Merlot – \$6.99-\$9.99.
The Chardonnay is my favorite and I compare it to Rombauer, which is a \$40 bottle.

Red Truck, California Red – \$7.99

Bogle, Reds & White – \$7.99-\$9.99. The Bogle Phantom is outstanding, a bit more in cost at \$16.99 but well worth it. It's hard to find.
